 Alternative Feed Formulation (with the use of inoccula, molasses and corn meal mix with greens found at the community)

c. Health Management (Castration, Proper Injection and Deworming)

 d. Meat Processing, Labelling and Marketing (Longganisa and Tocino, etc. Processing)

e. Record Keeping

Said trainings sessions will be conducted on-site in a staggered manner, with only two consecutive sessions held per week in each community. The first session will cover basic swine production and nutrition as well as alternative feed formulation, followed by the meat processing, labeling and marketing and bookkeeping session. Additionally, a separate off-site training session will be conducted for health management (castration, deworming and proper injection). Each training session will be held for a full day

The food and honoraria for the Resource Speakers and transportation (for the Off-site training) shall also be provided by the CONTRACTOR.

# 2. PROVISION AND DELIVERY OF MATERIALS/EQUIPMENT

All inputs and or materials and equipment intended for the implementation of the Swine Dispersal project such as training materials and piglets shall be delivered at the project site by the CONTRACTOR.

A total of 35 heads enumerating 31 gilts and 4 boars shall be provided for this project. Of these, 27 heads shall be distributed at Sitio Bantic, Dalupirip and the remaining eight (8) heads shall be distributed at Sitio Daynet, Ampucao, both areas in Itogon, Benguet. The sex ratio is presented below:

The piglets to be delivered must be of the F1 or upgraded Philippine native pig breed with at least 50-50% bloodline. They must be between 45-60 days old at the time of delivery, weigh a minimum of 10 kg per head and have been vaccinated against hogcholera and dewormed.

To ensure the health and adaptability of the delivered piglets, the CONTRACTOR must provide a 30-day quarantine/warranty for the foundation stock upon delivery. Poor quality foundation stock or underlying health issues can result in a hih mortality rate. Therefore, in the event of death/mortality during the quarantine period or upon delivery, the CONTRACTOR must replace them within seven (7) days, provided that the mortality was not due to the beneficiaries' negligence.

In cases where the piglets deaths were due to the poor quality of the stock, the beneficiaries must provide a Death Report certified by the MunicipaL Agriculturist (LGU) and a sworn statement from two disinterested persons as a requirement for replacement. The DCLA and OBLLA must also report the piglets' status immediately to the NPC-SRWAT within 24 hours through short message service (sms)/text, messenger or any other means and submit full documentation within five (5) days. Non-compliance within the prescribed period will forfeit the warranty.

In addition, the CONTRACTOR must comply with certain regulations to ensure that the piglets are delivered in good condition and free from diseases. These include:

- a. Department of Agriculture-Administrative Order No. 19, Series of 2006, which ensures the five basic freedoms of animals, namely: (1) Freedom from thirts, hunger and malnutirition; (2) Freedom from physical discomfort and pain; (3) Freedom from injury and diseases; (4) Freedom to conform to essential behavior pattern; and (5) Freedom from fear and distress during land transport.
- b. DA-AO No. 5, Series of 2019, 8 "Guidelines on the Local Transport/Shipment of Animals, Animal Products and By-Products."
- DA-Circular No. 12, Series of 2019, also known as the "National Zoning and Movement Plan for the Prevention and Control of African Swine Fever.

prevent the spread of African Swine CONTRACTOR must ensure that the piglets come from designated free zones, which are geographic areas that remain free from the ASF virus.

Furthermore, the CONTRACTOR must submit proceedings, reports and evaluations on the activity conducted.

ARTICLE XI
LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Should CONTRACTOR fail to satisfactorily deliver any or all of the Goods and/or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in this Contract inclusive of duly granted time extensions if any, NPC shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under this Contract and under the applicable law, deduct from the Contract Price, as liquidated damages, the applicable rate of one tenth (1/10) of one (1) percent of the cost of unperformed portion for every day of delay until actual delivery or performance. Once the amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%), NPC may rescind or terminate the Contract without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.

# ARTICLE XII NON-ASSIGNMENT AND NO SUB-CONTRACT

The CONTRACTOR shall not, without the written approval of NPC, assign, transfer, pledge, sub-contract, or make any other disposition of interest in this Contract. Any unapproved assignment, transfer, pledge, sub-contracting or any other disposition, shall be sufficient ground for NPC to terminate or cancel this Contract motu proprio without need of judicial action. Should NPC give its written approval, such consent shall not relieve the CONTRACTOR of its responsibilities under the Contract. The CONTRACTOR shall ensure that the terms and conditions of any sub-contract shall comply and conform with the terms and conditions of this Contract. The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for the observance by the sub-CONTRACTOR of the terms and conditions of this Contract.

If any portion of the project sub-contracted is not performed faithfully in accordance with the contract, the sub-CONTRACTOR shall be removed or replaced immediately upon the written request of NPC, provided, however, that any failure of NPC to make such request shall not relieve the CONTRACTOR of its obligations under the contract. NPC shall not be responsible for the delays or costs incurred by the CONTRACTOR because of the disapproval or removal of the sub-CONTRACTOR, or because of the late submission of its approval.

# ARTICLE XIII AGREEMENT MODIFICATION

No modification, alteration or waiver of any provision of this agreement shall be binding upon the Parties unless evidenced by a written amendment signed by the Parties.

ARTICLE XIV
SUSPENSION OF WORK

NPC may suspend the work wholly or partly by written order for a certain period of time, as it deems necessary due to force majeure or any fortuitous events as defined in the contract. The CONTRACTOR shall take all reasonable steps to minimize the costs allocable to the work covered by such order during work stoppage.

Before the suspension order expires, the procuring entity concerned shall either lift such order or terminate the work covered by the same. If the suspension order is lifted, or if the period of the order expires, the CONTRACTOR shall have the right to resume work. Appropriate adjustments shall be made in the delivery or contract schedule, or contract price, or both, and the contract shall be modified accordingly.

# ARTICLE XV PRE-TERMINATION

Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, NPC has the right to terminate, cancel and/or rescind this contract motu proprio, without need of judicial action, in case of breach thereof by the CONTRACTOR, by giving at least ten (10) day written notice, which shall be final and binding on all parties. Upon receipt of NPC's notice, the CONTRACTOR cannot remove, withdraw or pull-out any equipment, machinery, tool, material and supply brought to the project site without the written approval of NPC.

Any misrepresentation made by the CONTRACTOR in the submission of documents, or suppression of material facts, which if known could have disqualified the CONTRACTOR gives NPC the immediate right or recourse to motu proprio, without need of judicial action, rescind, abrogate or otherwise terminate the Contract.

Within thirty (30) days after termination, cancellation or rescission of this Contract, the Parties shall settle their respective accountabilities as of the date of termination, cancellation, or rescission, including the refund of any and all advances made, plus legal interest from the date of receipt of the amount or amount advanced.

# ARTICLE XVI WARRANTY CLAUSE
