NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing premises and for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and stipulations hereinafter provided, the parties hereto have agreed as follows:

# ARTICLE I DOCUMENTS COMPRISING THE CONTRACT

The following documents are hereby incorporated and made part of this Contract as though fully written out and set forth herein insofar as they are not inconsistent with the terms hereof:

- Terms of Reference for the Preventive Maintenance of the Addressable Fire Detection Alarm and Suppression System (FDASS) for NPC Head Office and Records & Training Center Minuyan (HO-TFM24-002) / SVP240115-KL00020;
- Result of Bid Opening and Post-qualification Report dated 01 February 2024;
- 3. CONTRACTOR's bid proposal dated 12 January 2024;
- 4. Notice of Award dated 21 February 2024;
- 5. Notice to Proceed; and
- The Performance Security to be filed by CONTRACTOR in accordance with this Contract.

The documents mentioned above shall collectively be referred to as "Contract Documents".

In the event that there is any discrepancy/inconsistency between the provisions of the Contract and the Contract Documents mentioned above, the latter shall govern. Should there be any inconsistency/discrepancy, among the Contract Documents, the document with the latest date shall prevail.

#### ARTICLE II GENERAL

The Contract covers the requirements for the furnishing of labor for the Preventive Maintenance of the Addressable Fire Detection Alarm and Suppression System (FDASS) for NPC Head Office and Records & Training Center Minuyan.

The Contractor shall accept full responsibility for his work including the following:

- Provide services of highly qualified and experienced technical personnel having expertise in the operation, maintenance and testing of the system.
- Submission of reports / checklist for every preventive maintenance schedule to the concerned NPC representative.
- Warranty on Service: Maintenance Services shall be "On Call" when there are troubles/problems in the systems or additional maintenance needed during contract period including weekends and holidays.
- Contractor is required to submit name(s), hotline contact number on a twenty-four (24) hour basis available even weekends and holidays.
- 5. Duration of works shall be two (2) to three (3) days for every preventive maintenance schedule.
- Submission of update/revise As-Built Plan/Diagram, layout of wirings & field devices/system as needed.
- Major services/works in installation/relocation of field devices shall be free of charge to NPC as well as re-programming of the system.
- 8. Provide security code/password of the system.

#### ARTICLE III SCOPE OF WORKS

Below are the scope of works to be done on a monthly basis, quarterly and yearly basis, which shall start upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed:

### Monthly Basis (2<sup>nd</sup> week of the month):

 Check the Light Emitting Diode (LCD) displays and all wiring terminal per circuit of the alarm control panel.

Check electrical piping, wiring installation and its hanger support.

- Gather data for dirty smoke or heat detectors.

#### ARTICLE IV CONTRACT DURATION AND LOCATION

The contract period shall be one (1) year with monthly, quarterly and annual preventive maintenance services for NPC-Head Office and Records & Training Center Minuyan reckoned from the date stated in the Notice to Proceed.

#### **ARTICLE V** LIABILITIES

CONTRACTOR shall be liable and shall indemnify NPC for any loss, damages or injury of NPC due to or arising from the fault, other unlawful vandalism or negligence, employees/workers.

NPC shall have the right to deduct from any money payable to the CONTRACTOR amount/s equivalent to any damage it may suffer or liability it may incur due to the fault negligence of the latter's workers.

### ARTICLE VI TOTAL CONTRACT PRICE AND PAYMENT TERMS

For and in consideration of the WORKS to be undertaken by the CONTRACTOR as specified in Article III hereof, NPC shall pay the CONTRACTOR in the Philippines Pesos and in accordance with the Contract documents the amount of Nine Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Pesos Only (PhP 985,000.00). ## ARTICLE VII PERFORMANCE SECURITY

To guarantee the faithful performance of the CONTRACTOR's obligation under this Contract, the CONTRACTOR shall post a performance security which shall remain valid and effective during the contract duration.

- a. Cash, Manager's/Cashier's Check, Bank Draft/Guarantee issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank or Irrevocable Letter of Credit issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank. Provided however, that it shall be confirmed or authenticated by a Universal or Commercial Bank if issued by a Foreign Bank which shall be Five Percent (5%) of the total Contract price.
- b. Surety Bond callable upon demand and penal in nature issued by a Surety or Insurance Company duly accredited by the Insurance Commission as authorized to issue such security which shall be Thirty Percent (30%) of the total contract price. The Insurance company that will issue Performance Security must be accredited by the Insurance Commission and acceptable to the National Power Corporation.

The Insurance Company that will issue Performance Security must be accredited by the Insurance Commission and acceptable to NPC.

The performance security shall be valid for the duration of the contract and shall remain valid and effective until after sixty (60) days from NPC's final acceptance of the project, unless the contract duration is extended, in which case the validity of the performance security shall accordingly be extended.

This performance security shall also be answerable for any damages or penalties or any expenses that NPC may suffer as a result of the failure of the CONTRACTOR to perform its obligation under this Contract including the defects liability period of one year. The Performance Security shall be entirely confiscated by NPC upon default of CONTRACTOR.

In case of surety bond, any extension of the contract time granted to the CONTRACTOR, shall be considered as given, and any modification of the contract shall be considered as authorized, as if with the expressed consent of the surety, provided that such extension or modifications falls within the effective period of the said surety bond. However, in the event that the extension of the contract time would be beyond the effective period of the surety bond first posted, it shall be the sole obligation of the

The performance security shall be discharged by NPC and return to the CONTRACTOR only after the required warranty security/guarantee bond shall have been posted by the CONTRACTOR.

After the lapse of the warranty period, provided that there are no defects found and/or pending repair works, NPC shall release the warranty/acceptance certificate.

#### ARTICLE VIII LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Should CONTRACTOR fail to satisfactorily deliver any or all the GOODS and/or perform the services within the period specified in this Contract inclusive of duly granted time extensions, if any, NPC shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under this Contract and under the applicable law, deduct from the Contract Price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to one tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the contract cost of the delay/unperformed portion for every day of delay until actual delivery or performance. Once the amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%), the NPC may rescind the contract without prejudice to other course of action and remedies open to it.

## ARTICLE IX NON-ASSIGNMENT AND NO SUB-CONTRACTING

The CONTRACTOR shall not, without the written approval of NPC, assign, transfer, pledge, sub-contract, or make any other disposition of interest in this Contract. Any unapproved assignment, transfer, pledge, sub-contracting or any other disposition, shall be sufficient ground for NPC to terminate or cancel this Contract motu proprio without need of judicial action. Should NPC give its written approval, such consent shall not relieve the CONTRACTOR of its responsibilities under the Contract. The CONTRACTOR shall ensure that the terms and conditions of any sub-contract shall comply and conform with the terms and conditions of this Contract. The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for the observance by the sub-contractor of the terms and conditions of this Contract.

If any portion of the project sub-contracted is not performed faithfully in accordance with the contract, the sub-contractor shall be removed or replaced immediately upon the written request of NPC. provided, however, that any failure of NPC to make such request shall not relieve the CONTRACTOR of its obligations under the contract. NPC shall not be responsible for the delays or costs incurred by the CONTRACTOR because of the disapproval or removal of the sub-contractor, or because of the late submission of its approval.

#### **ARTICLE X** AGREEMENT MODIFICATION

No modification, alteration or waiver of any provision of this agreement shall be binding upon the Parties unless evidenced by a written amendment signed by the Parties.

#### ARTICLE XI SUSPENSION OF WORK

NPC may suspend the work wholly or partly by written order for a certain period of time, as it deems necessary due to force majeure or any fortuitous events as defined in the contract. The contractor shall take all reasonable steps to minimize the costs allocable to the work covered by such order during work stoppage.

Before the suspension order expires, the procuring entity concerned shall either lift such order or terminate the work covered by the same. If the suspension order is lifted, or if the period of the order expires, the supplier shall have the right to resume work. Appropriate adjustments shall be made in the delivery or contract schedule, or contract price, or both, and the contract shall be modified accordingly.

#### ARTICLE XII PRE-TERMINATION

Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, NPC has the right to terminate, cancel and/or rescind this contract motu proprio, without need of judicial action, in case of breach thereof by the CONTRACTOR, by giving at least ten (10) day written notice, which shall be final and binding on all parties. Upon receipt of NPC's notice, the SUPPLIER cannot remove, withdraw or pull-out any equipment, machinery, tool, material and supply brought to the project site without the written approval of NPC.

Any misrepresentation made by the CONTRACTOR in the submission of documents, or suppression of material facts, which if known

Within thirty (30) days after termination, cancellation or rescission of this Contract, the Parties shall settle their respective accountabilities as of the date of termination, cancellation, or rescission, including the refund of any and all advances made, plus legal interest from the date of receipt of the amount or amount advanced.

## ARTICLE XIII WARRANTY CLAUSE

CONTRACTOR hereby warrants that it or its representative has not offered or paid, directly or indirectly, any government officer and NPC official or employee any consideration or commission for the Contract nor has it or its representative exerted or utilized any corrupt or unlawful this Contract for any consideration or influence to secure or solicit commission; that the CONTRACTOR will not subcontract any portion or portions of the scope of work of the Contract awarded to it to any official or employee of the NPC and to the relatives within the 3rd degree of consanguinity or affinity of NPC's officials who are directly and indirectly involved in Contract awards or project execution; and that if any commission is being paid to a private person; it shall disclose the name of said person and the amount being paid; and that any violation of this Warranty shall constitute sufficient ground for the rescission or cancellation of this Contract; or the reduction from the Contract Price of the consideration or commission paid without prejudice to the filing of any action for the violation of RA No. 3019 as amended (otherwise known as the Anti-Graft and Corrupt Practices Act) and/or other applicable laws against the CONTRACTOR and/or its representative and/or the erring NPC official(s) and employee(s).

## ARTICLE XIV VALIDITY CLAUSE

If any term or condition of this Contract is held invalid or contrary to law, the validity of the other terms and conditions hereof shall not be affected thereby.

#### ARTICLE XV EFFECTIVITY

This Contract shall become effective upon the receipt of the Notice to Proceed.
