WITNESSETH: That -

WHEREAS, NPC thru its Transportation and Facilities Management Division, General Services Department, needs a contract for the Preventive Maintenance of the Addressable Fire Detection System & Suppression System (FDAS) at NPC Head Office and Records/Training Center, Minuyan, SJDM, Bulacan.

WHEREAS, to respond to the above-mentioned requirement, the enduser submitted Purchase Requisition and recommended the procurement of the Preventive Maintenance of the Addressable Fire Detection System & Suppression System (FDAS) through NP-Small Value Procurement under Section 53.9 of RA 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR;

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR's quotation was considered as the single calculated and responsive quotation;

WHEREAS, NPC accepted the said bid of the CONTRACTOR;

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing premises and for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and stipulations hereinafter provided, the parties hereto have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE I DOCUMENTS COMPRISING THE CONTRACT

The following documents are hereby incorporated and made part of this Contract as though fully written out and set forth herein insofar as they are not inconsistent with the terms hereof:

- Terms of Reference for Preventive Maintenance of the Addressable Fire Detection System & Suppression System (FDAS) at NPC Head Office and Records/Training Center, Minuyan, SJDM, Bulacan, under HO-TFM23-006 / SVP221110-RG;
- Result of Bid Opening and Post Qualification Report dated 29 November 2022;
- 3. CONTRACTOR's bid proposal dated 10 November 2022;
- 4. Notice of Award dated 21 December 2022;
- 5. Notice to Proceed: and
- The Performance Security to be filed by CONTRACTOR in accordance with this Contract.

The documents mentioned above shall collectively be referred to as "Contract Documents".

In the event that there is any discrepancy/inconsistency between the provisions of the Contract and the Contract Documents mentioned above, the latter shall govern. Should there be any inconsistency/discrepancy, among the Contract Documents, the document with the latest date shall prevail.

ARTICLE II GENERAL

The Contract covers the technical requirements for the furnishing of labor for the Preventive Maintenance of the Addressable Fire Detection System & Suppression System (FDAS) at NPC Head Office and Records/Training Center, Minuyan, SJDM, Bulacan.

The Contractor shall accept full responsibility for his work including the following:

- Provide services of highly qualified and experienced technical personnel having expertise in the operation, maintenance and testing of the system.
- Submission of reports/checklist for every preventive maintenance schedule 4 to 5 days after the services conducted to the concerned NPC representative.
- Warranty on Service: Maintenance Services shall be "On Call" when there are troubles/problems in the systems or additional maintenance needed during contract period including weekends and holidays.
- Contractor is required to submit name(s), hotline contact number on a twenty-four (24)-hour basis available even weekends and holidays.
- Duration of works shall be 3 to 4 days for every preventive maintenance schedule.
- Major works/relocation/replacement of field devices shall be free of charge to NPC as well as programming of the systems.
- 7. Provide security code/password of the system.
- Submission of update/revise as built-in plan/diagram, layout of wirings & field devices/system as needed.

ARTICLE III SCOPE OF WORKS

The scope of works to be done on a monthly basis, quarterly and yearly basis, which shall start upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed:

Monthly Basis (2nd week of the month):

- Check the Light Emitting Diode (LCD) displays and all wiring terminal per circuit of the main alarm control panels and remote display control module (MACP & RDCM) of the Fire Detection Alarm and Suppression System.
- Check program and proper display of all addressable field devices of the main alarm control panels of FDAS and Suppression System.
- Check on any unusual apprearance or condition of devices and fault system of the main fire alarm control panels.
- Test the main fire alarm control panel and control head of the suppression using AC and DC operation.
- Check, clean and random test of Smoke, Heat Detectors, Manual Pull Station, Alarm Bell, Siren, Strobe (audible & signal).
- Check field devices (Smoke, Heat & Manual Pull Station).
- Visual Check (Smoke, Heat & Manual Pull Station, Alarm Bell, Siren Strobe Gauge and Control Head) for any

- Check (Smoke, Heat & Manual Pull and Abort Station) wiring terminal.
- Check switches/contact for corrosion of Manual Pull and Abort Station.
- Check the automatic Voltage Regulator (AVR) and Batteries' terminals/contacts for any corrosion and address location test battery voltage capacity as back-up batteries for Main Alarm Control Panel.
- Test the back-up batteries for about ten (10) minutes without AC power supply.
- Check electrical piping, wiring installation and its hanger support.
- Check the system for open, short and grounded wiring per loop/circuit.

Quarterly Basis (4th week of the month):

- Gather and print event history of the main control panels.
- Gather data for dirty smoke or heat detectors.
- Sensitivity test of all field devices (Smoke, Heat and Manual Pull Station).
- Testing and Checking the modules/power supplies of General Alarm Panel.
- Test the General Alarm without AC power supply for three (3) hours using batteries.
- Inspection of all piping, supports and obstruction.

Yearly Basis (4th week of the month)

- 1. Check and re-calibrate control panel data.
- Re-calibrate field detectors (Heat, Smoke & Manual Pull).
- Cleaning of all field devices such as Smoke/Heat Detectors, Manual Pull Stations and Fire Alarm Bells.
- General alarm for continuous five (5) minutes.
- General cleaning of all modules of control panel.

ARTICLE IV CONTRACT DURATION AND LOCATION

The contract period shall be **one (1) year**, with monthly, quarterly, and annual preventive maintenance services NPC Head Office and Records/ Training Center, Minuyan, SJDM, Bulacan reckoned from the issuance date of the Notice to Proceed.

ARTICLE V LIABILITIES

CONTRACTOR shall be liable and shall indemnify NPC for any loss, damages or injury of NPC due to or arising from the fault, negligence, vandalism or other unlawful acts of its employees/workers.

CONTRACTOR shall also be held liable to, and shall indemnify third (3rd) person/s for claims arising from the fault and/or negligence of its employees/workers assigned in the premises of the NPC.

NPC shall have the right to deduct from any money payable to the Supplier amount/s equivalent to any damage it may suffer or liability it may incur due to the fault negligence of the latter's workers.

ARTICLE VI TOTAL CONTRACT PRICE AND PAYMENT TERMS

For and in consideration of the WORKS to be undertaken by the CONTRACTOR as specified in Article III hereof, NPC shall pay the CONTRACTOR in Philippine Pesos and in accordance with the Contract documents the amount of NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND PESOS (P 980,000.00).

Upon accomplishment of monthly Preventive Maintenance of Fire Detection Alarm System at NPC Head Office and Records/Training Center, Minuyan, SJDM, Bulacan, the Contractor shall submit the maintenance report at least five (5) days after the scheduled maintenance/service with their Service Invoice attached. Thirty (30) days payment upon submission of complete documents/attachments.

ARTICLE VII PERFORMANCE SECURITY

To guarantee the faithful performance of the CONTRACTOR's obligation under this Contract, the CONTRACTOR shall post a performance security which shall remain valid and effective during the contract duration.

- Cash, Manager's/Cashier's Check, Bank Draft/Guarantee issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank or Irrevocable Letter of Credit issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank. Provided however, that it shall be confirmed or authenticated by a Universal or Commercial Bank if issued by a Foreign Bank which shall be Five Percent (5%) of the total Contract price.
- Surety Bond callable upon demand and penal in nature issued by a Surety or Insurance Company duly accredited by the Insurance Commission as authorized to issue such security which shall be Thirty Percent (30%) of the total contract price. The Insurance company that will issue Performance Security must be accredited by the Insurance Commission and acceptable to the National

c. Performance Securing Declaration.

The Insurance Company that will issue Performance Security must be accredited by the Insurance Commission and acceptable to the National Power Corporation.

The performance security shall be valid for the duration of the contract and shall remain valid and effective until after sixty (60) days from NPC's final acceptance of the project, unless the contract duration is extended, in which case the validity of the performance security shall accordingly be extended.

This performance security shall also be answerable for any damages or penalties or any expenses that NPC may suffer as a result of the failure of the CONTRACTOR to perform its obligation under this Contract including the defects liability period of one year. The Performance Security shall be entirely confiscated by NPC upon default of CONTRACTOR.

In case of surety bond, any extension of the contract time granted to the CONTRACTOR, shall be considered as given, and any modification of the contract shall be considered as authorized, as if with the expressed consent of the surety, provided that such extension or modifications falls within the effective period of the said surety bond. However, in the event that the extension of the contract time would be beyond the effective period of the surety bond first posted, it shall be the sole obligation of the CONTRACTOR to post an acceptable Performance Security within ten (10) calendar days after the contract time extension has been granted by NPC.

The performance security shall be discharged by NPC and return to the CONTRACTOR only after the required warranty security/guarantee bond shall have been posted by the CONTRACTOR.

ARTICLE VIII LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Should CONTRACTOR fail to satisfactorily complete the WORK within the stipulated contract time, plus any time extension duly granted and is hereby in default under this Contract, CONTRACTOR shall pay liquidated damages to NPC for each day that the Completion Date is later than the intended Completion Date. The applicable liquidated damages is at least one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the unperformed portion for every day of delay. NPC shall deduct liquidated damages from payments due to CONTRACTOR. Payment of liquidated damages shall not affect the CONTRACTOR's liabilities. Once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of this Contract, NPC may rescind or terminate this Contract without prejudice to other course of action and remedies available under circumstances.

ARTICLE X VALIDITY CLAUSE

If any term or condition of this Contract is held invalid or contrary to law, the validity of the other terms and conditions hereof shall not be affected thereby.

ARTICLE XI GOVERNING LAW

The contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

ARTICLE XII VENUE OF ACTION

The parties hereto agree that the venue of action for any cause or causes of action which may arise in connection with this Contract shall be exclusively in the proper court of Quezon City, Philippines only.
