WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee recommended the conduct of Alternative Mode of Procurement (AMP) – Negotiated Procurement (Two Failed Biddings) and was approved by the Officer-in-Charge per Bid Opening Report dated 19 October 2021;

WHEREAS, on 10 December 2021, NPC posted the Invitation to Bid for the Negotiated Procurement for the Lease of 1.0 MW Modular Diesel Generating Set for El Nido DPP, El NIdo, Palawan;

WHEREAS, only one (1) prospective bidder secured the terms

WHEREAS, LESSOR's bid offer is the single calculated and responsive bid;

WHEREAS, LESSEE accepted the said bid of the LESSOR;

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing premises and for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and stipulations hereinafter provided, the parties hereto have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE I DOCUMENTS COMPRISING THE CONTRACT

The following documents are hereby incorporated and made part of this Contract as though fully written out and set forth herein insofar as they are not inconsistent with the terms hereof:

- Terms of Reference for the Lease of 1.0 MW Modular Diesel Generating Sets for El Nido Diesel Power Plant located at El Nido, Palawan;
- Bid Opening Report dated 19 October 2021, for the approval of Alternative Mode of Procurement-Negotiated Procurement (Two Failed Biddings);
- 3. Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 1 dated 22 December 2021;
- 4. LESSOR's bid proposal dated 29 December 2021;
- Bid Opening Report dated 29 December 2021;
- 6. Post Qualification Report dated 06 January 2022;
- 7. Notice of Award dated 21 January 2022;
- 8. Notice to Proceed; and
- The Performance Security to be filed by LESSOR in accordance with this Contract.

In the event that there is any discrepancy/inconsistency between the provisions of the Contract and the Contract Documents mentioned above, the latter shall govern. Should there be any inconsistency/discrepancy, among the Contract Documents, the document with the latest date shall prevail.

ARTICLE II SCOPE OF CONTRACT

LESSOR shall provide 1.0 MW Modular Diesel Generating Set for El Nido Diesel Power Plant located at El Nido Palawan. Scope of Work and related services to be provided by the LESSOR are contained in the Terms of Reference and Annex "A" showing the itemized Bid Price Schedule.

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ARTICLE III COMMENCEMENT AND COMPLETION PERIOD

The delivery, installation, testing and commissioning of the modular diesel generating sets shall be completed by the LESSOR in twenty (20) calendar days reckoned from NPC's issuance of the Notice to Proceed. Commercial operation of the plant shall commence after the completion of the works.

The lease/contract duration shall be six (6) months minimum and twelve (12) months maximum period effective on the issuance of Notice to Proceed. It should be understood that such contract can be terminated any time after the first six (6) months minimum period of operation at the discretion of NPC depending on the power requirement of the local power system and the progress on NPC-SPUG plant expansion program.

ARTICLE IV TOTAL CONTRACT PRICE AND PAYMENT TERMS

The Total Contract Price of the lease shall be in the amount of PHILIPPINE PESOS: EIGHTEEN MILLION NINE HUNDRED FOURTEEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY PESOS (PHP 18,914,980.00),ONLY.

The Total Contract Price specified above shall be paid in accordance with the provisions of Section II, Clause GCC, Item 10, of the Terms of Reference. All taxes, customs duties, tariffs, exports, excise and all other taxes assessed and charged by the taxing authority of the country of origin upon production, manufacture or shipment of all materials, equipment and supplies to be furnished under the Contract shall be borne by the LESSOR.

In addition, all taxes, fees, insurance and cost of delivery to site shall be borne by the LESSOR.

ARTICLE V EXTENSION OF CONTRACT

NPC has the option to extend the contract on a month to month basis subject to the availability of funds and applicable provisions of the RA 9184 and its revised IRR.

The basis for computation of monthly extension shall be based on Section II, Clause GCC, Item 11-3.7

ARTICLE VI PERFORMANCE SECURITY

To guarantee the faithful performance of the LESSOR's obligation under this Contract, the LESSOR shall post a Performance Security which shall remain valid and effective during the contract duration.

- a. Cash Manager's/Cashier's Check, Bank Draft/Guarantee issued by a Universal Bank, or Irrevocable Letter of Credit issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank: provided however, that it shall be confirmed or authenticated by a reputable local Universal or Commercial Bank, if issued by a foreign bank, equivalent to five percent (5%) of the contract price.
- b. Surety Bond callable upon demand and penal in nature by a Surety or Insurance Company duly certified by the Insurance Commission as authorized to issue such security which shall be Thirty Percent (30%) of the total contract price.
 - c. Performance Securing Declaration.

The Insurance Company that will issue Performance Security must be accredited by the Insurance Commission and acceptable to the National Power Corporation.

The Performance Bond shall be valid for the duration of the contract and remain valid and effective until after sixty (60) days, from NPC's issuance of Certificate of Demobilization. In case of surety bond, should there be any extension of the contract period, the LESSOR shall correspondingly post an extension of the bond within ten (10) days from the notice. The Performance Bond shall also be answerable for any damages or penalties or any expenses incurred that LESSEE may suffer as a result of the failure of the LESSOR to perform its obligations under this Contract. The Performance Bond shall be entirely forfeited by LESSEE upon default of LESSOR.


ARTICLE VII LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Should LESSOR fail to satisfactorily deliver any or all the Goods and/or perform the Services within the period(s) specified in this Contract inclusive of duly granted time extensions, if any, LESSEE shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under this Contract and under the applicable law, deduct from the Contract Price, as liquidated damages, the applicable rate of one tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the unperformed portion for every day actual Delivery or performance. Once the amount damages reaches ten percent (10%), the LESSEE may liquidated rescind or terminate the contract without prejudice to other course of
