For completed power plant under item 2, the required PSA/PPA shall not be subject of evaluation using the point system. In case of tie, the bidders will be ranked from the highest to the lowest contract amount, up to Rank 7. If a tie still exists, a "toss coin" or "draw lots" (for multiple ties) will be used as the tie-breaking method, subject to the provisions of the applicable laws.
