ABC – Approved Budget for the Contract.

ARCC – Allowable Range of Contract Cost.

BAC – Bids and Awards Committee.

Bid – A signed offer or proposal to undertake a contract submitted by a bidder in response to and in consonance with the requirements of the bidding documents. Also referred to as *Proposal* and *Tender*. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[c])

Bidder – Refers to a contractor, manufacturer, supplier, distributor and/or consultant who submits a bid in response to the requirements of the Bidding Documents. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[d])

Bidding Documents – The documents issued by the Procuring Entity as the bases for bids, furnishing all information necessary for a prospective bidder to prepare a bid for the Goods, Infrastructure Projects, and/or Consulting Services required by the Procuring Entity. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[e])

BIR – Bureau of Internal Revenue.

BSP – Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas.

CDA – Cooperative Development Authority.

Consulting Services – Refer to services for Infrastructure Projects and other types of projects or activities of the GOP requiring adequate external technical and professional expertise that are beyond the capability and/or capacity of the GOP to undertake such as, but not limited to: (i) advisory and review services; (ii) pre-investment or feasibility studies; (iii) design; (iv) construction supervision; (v) management and related services; and (vi) other technical services or special studies. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[i])

Contract – Refers to the agreement entered into between the Procuring Entity and the Supplier or Manufacturer or Distributor or Service Provider for procurement of Goods and Services; Contractor for Procurement of Infrastructure Projects; or Consultant or Consulting Firm for Procurement of Consulting Services; as the case may be, as recorded in the Contract Form signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.

Contractor – is a natural or juridical entity whose proposal was accepted by the Procuring Entity and to whom the Contract to execute the Work was awarded. Contractor as used in these Bidding Documents may likewise refer to a supplier, distributor, manufacturer, or consultant.

CPI – Consumer Price Index.

DOLE – Department of Labor and Employment.

DTI – Department of Trade and Industry.

Foreign-funded Procurement or Foreign-Assisted Project –Refers to procurement whose funding source is from a foreign government, foreign or international financing institution as specified in the Treaty or International or Executive Agreement. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[b]).

GFI – Government Financial Institution.

GOCC –Government-owned and/or –controlled corporation.

Goods – Refer to all items, supplies, materials and general support services, except Consulting Services and Infrastructure Projects, which may be needed in the transaction of public businesses or in the pursuit of any government undertaking, project or activity, whether in the nature of equipment, furniture, stationery, materials for construction, or personal property of any kind, including non-personal or contractual services such as the repair and maintenance of equipment and furniture, as well as trucking, hauling, janitorial, security, and related or analogous services, as well as procurement of materials and supplies provided by the Procuring Entity for such services. The term “related” or “analogous services” shall include, but is not limited to, lease or purchase of office space, media advertisements, health maintenance services, and other services essential to the operation of the Procuring Entity. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[r])

Infrastructure Projects – Include the construction, improvement, rehabilitation, demolition, repair, restoration or maintenance of roads and bridges, railways, airports, seaports, communication facilities, civil works components of information technology projects, irrigation, flood control and drainage, water supply, sanitation, sewerage and solid waste management systems, shore protection, energy/power and electrification facilities, national buildings, school buildings, hospital buildings, and other related construction projects of the government. 1. The *NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION-MINDANAO GENERATION*, through the *approved Corporate Budget of NPC for CY 2023* intends to apply the sum of *Three Million Nine Hundred Ninety Nine Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Six Pesos & 95/100 (PHP 3,999,686.95)* being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for *Grouting of Riprap of Retaining Wall of Spillway Dam at Agus 2 HEPP Saguiaran, Lanao del Sur (INFRA2023-RDW-004)*. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The *NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION-MINDANAO GENERATION* now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Completion of the Works is required *Forty Two (42) calendar days*. Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "*pass/fail*" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from *BAC Secretariat, NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION-MINDANAO GENERATION* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from *8:00 AM – 5:00 PM Monday to Friday*.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on *January 24 – February 14, 2023* from the given address and website(s) below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of *Five Thousand Pesos (PHP 5,000.00)*. 9. Bid opening shall be on *February 14, 2023 at 9:30 AM* at the *Bidding Room, NPC-Mindanao Generation Headquarters, Maria Cristina, Iligan City*. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.

Section II. Instructions to Bidders

1. Scope of Bid

The Procuring Entity, *NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION-MINDANAO GENERATION* invites Bids for the *Grouting of Riprap of Retaining Wall of Spillway Dam at Agus 2 HEPP, Saguiaran, Lanao del Sur, with Project Identification Number INFRA2023-RDIV-004.*

The Procurement Project (referred to herein as "Project") is for the construction of Works, as described in Section VI (Specifications).

2. Funding Information

- 2.1. The GOP through the source of funding as indicated below for CY 2023 in the amount of *Three Million Nine Hundred Ninety Nine Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Six and 95/100 Pesos (PHP 3,999,686.95)*
- 2.2. The source of funding is:
 - a. GOCC and GFIs, the proposed Corporate Operating Budget.

3. Bidding Requirements

The Bidding for the Project shall be governed by all the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including its Generic Procurement Manual and associated policies, rules and regulations as the primary source thereof, while the herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source thereof.

Any amendments made to the IRR and other GPPB issuances shall be applicable only to the ongoing posting, advertisement, or invitation to bid by the BAC through the issuance of a supplemental or bid bulletin.

The Bidder, by the act of submitting its Bid, shall be deemed to have inspected the site, determined the general characteristics of the contracted Works and the conditions for this Project, such as the location and the nature of the work; (b) climatic conditions; (c) transportation facilities; (e) nature and condition of the terrain, geological conditions at the site communication facilities, requirements, location and availability of construction aggregates and other materials, labor, water, electric power and access roads; and (d) other factors that may affect the cost, duration and execution or implementation of the contract, project, or work and examine all instructions, forms, terms, and project requirements in the Bidding Documents.

4. Corrupt, Fraudulent, Collusive, Coercive, and Obstructive Practices

The Procuring Entity, as well as the Bidders and Contractors, shall observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of the contract. They or through an agent shall not engage in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, and obstructive practices defined under Annex "I" of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 or other integrity violations in competing for the Project.

5. Eligible Bidders

- 5.1. Only Bids of Bidders found to be legally, technically, and financially capable will be evaluated.
- 5.2. The Bidder must have an experience of having completed a Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC adjusted, if necessary, by the Bidder to current prices using the PSA's CPI, except under conditions provided for in Section 23.4.2.4 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

A contract is considered to be "similar" to the contract to be bid if it has the major categories of work stated in the BDS.

- 5.3. For Foreign-funded Procurement, the Procuring Entity and the foreign government/foreign or international financing institution may agree on another track record requirement, as specified in the Bidding Document prepared for this purpose.
- 5.4. The Bidders shall comply with the eligibility criteria under Section 23.4.2 of the 2016 IRR of RA No. 9184.

6. Origin of Associated Goods

There is no restriction on the origin of Goods other than those prohibited by a decision of the UN Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the UN.

7. Subcontracts

- 7.1. The Bidder may subcontract portions of the Project to the extent allowed by the Procuring Entity as stated herein, but in no case more than fifty percent (50%) of the Project.

The Procuring Entity has prescribed that:

- a. Subcontracting is not allowed.

8. Pre-Bid Conference

The Procuring Entity will hold a pre-bid conference for this Project on the specified date and time and either at its physical address and/or through videoconferencing/webcasting as indicated in paragraph 6 of the IB.

9. Clarification and Amendment of Bidding Documents

Prospective bidders may request for clarification on and/or interpretation of any part of the Bidding Documents. Such requests must be in writing and received by the Procuring Entity, either at its given address or through electronic mail indicated in the IB, at least ten (10) calendar days before the deadline set for the submission and receipt of Bids.

10. Documents Comprising the Bid: Eligibility and Technical Components

- 10.1. The first envelope shall contain the eligibility and technical documents of the Bid as specified in Section IX. Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents.
- 10.2. If the eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents for submission to the BAC are in foreign language other than English, it must be accompanied by a translation in English, which shall be authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment, post, or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines. For Contracting Parties to the Apostille Convention, only the translated documents shall be authenticated through an apostille pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 13-2019 dated 23 May 2019. The English translation shall govern, for purposes of interpretation of the bid.
- 10.3. A valid PCAB License is required, and in case of joint ventures, a valid special PCAB License, and registration for the type and cost of the contract for this Project. Any additional type of Contractor license or permit shall be indicated in the BDS.
- 10.4. A List of Contractor's key personnel (e.g., Project Manager, Project Engineers, Materials Engineers, and Foremen) assigned to the contract to be bid, with their complete qualification and experience data shall be provided. These key personnel must meet the required minimum years of experience set in the BDS.
- 10.5. A List of Contractor's major equipment units, which are owned, leased, and/or under purchase agreements, supported by proof of ownership, certification of availability of equipment from the equipment lessor/vendor for the duration of the project, as the case may be, must meet the minimum requirements for the contract set in the BDS.

11. Documents Comprising the Bid: Financial Component

- 11.1. The second bid envelope shall contain the financial documents for the Bid as specified in **Section IX, Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents**.
- 11.2. Any bid exceeding the ABC indicated in paragraph 1 of the IB shall not be accepted.
- 11.3. For Foreign-funded procurement, a ceiling may be applied to bid prices provided the conditions are met under Section 31.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

12. Alternative Bids

Bidders shall submit offers that comply with the requirements of the Bidding Documents, including the basic technical design as indicated in the drawings and specifications. Unless there is a value engineering clause in the BDS, alternative Bids shall not be accepted.

13. Bid Prices

All bid prices for the given scope of work in the Project as awarded shall be considered as fixed prices, and therefore not subject to price escalation during contract implementation, except under extraordinary circumstances as determined by the NEDA and approved by the GPPB pursuant to the revised Guidelines for Contract Price Escalation guidelines.

14. Bid and Payment Currencies

- 14.1. Bid prices may be quoted in the local currency or tradeable currency accepted by the BSP at the discretion of the Bidder. However, for purposes of bid evaluation, Bids denominated in foreign currencies shall be converted to Philippine currency based on the exchange rate as published in the BSP reference rate bulletin on the day of the bid opening.
- 14.2. *Payment of the contract price shall be made in:*
 - a. Philippine Pesos.

15. Bid Security

- 15.1. The Bidder shall submit a Bid Securing Declaration or any form of Bid Security in the amount indicated in the BDS, which shall be not less than the percentage of the ABC in accordance with the schedule in the BDS.
- 15.2. The Bid and bid security shall be valid until *One Hundred Twenty (120) Calendar Days from the Scheduled Bid Opening*. Any bid not accompanied

by an acceptable bid security shall be rejected by the Procuring Entity as non-responsive.

16. Sealing and Marking of Bids

Each Bidder shall submit one copy of the first and second components of its Bid.

The Procuring Entity may request additional hard copies and/or electronic copies of the Bid. However, failure of the Bidders to comply with the said request shall not be a ground for disqualification.

If the Procuring Entity allows the submission of bids through online submission to the given website or any other electronic means, the Bidder shall submit an electronic copy of its Bid, which must be digitally signed. An electronic copy that cannot be opened or is corrupted shall be considered non-responsive and, thus, automatically disqualified.

17. Deadline for Submission of Bids

The Bidders shall submit on the specified date and time and either at its physical address or through online submission as indicated in paragraph 7 of the IB.

18. Opening and Preliminary Examination of Bids

18.1. The BAC shall open the Bids in public at the time, on the date, and at the place specified in paragraph 9 of the IB. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance. In case videoconferencing, webcasting or other similar technologies will be used, attendance of participants shall likewise be recorded by the BAC Secretariat.

In case the Bids cannot be opened as scheduled due to justifiable reasons, the rescheduling requirements under Section 29 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall prevail.

18.2. The preliminary examination of Bids shall be governed by Section 30 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

19. Detailed Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

19.1. The Procuring Entity's BAC shall immediately conduct a detailed evaluation of all Bids rated "*passed*" using non-discretionary pass/fail criteria. The BAC shall consider the conditions in the evaluation of Bids under Section 32.2 of 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

19.2. If the Project allows partial bids, all Bids and combinations of Bids as indicated in the BDS shall be received by the same deadline and opened and evaluated simultaneously so as to determine the Bid or combination of Bids

offering the lowest calculated cost to the Procuring Entity. Bid Security as required by ITB Clause 16 shall be submitted for each contract (lot) separately.

- 19.3. In all cases, the NFCC computation pursuant to Section 23.4.2.6 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 must be sufficient for the total of the ABCs for all the lots participated in by the prospective Bidder.

20. Post Qualification

Within a non-extendible period of five (5) calendar days from receipt by the Bidder of the notice from the BAC that it submitted the Lowest Calculated Bid, the Bidder shall submit its latest income and business tax returns filed and paid through the BIR Electronic Filing and Payment System (eFPS), and other appropriate licenses and permits required by law and stated in the BDS.

21. Signing of the Contract

The documents required in Section 37.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall form part of the Contract. Additional Contract documents are indicated in the BDS.

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Section IV. General Conditions of Contract

1. Scope of Contract

This Contract shall include all such items, although not specifically mentioned, that can be reasonably inferred as being required for its completion as if such items were expressly mentioned herein. All the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including the Generic Procurement Manual, and associated issuances, constitute the primary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract, and thus, applicable in contract implementation. Herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract.

This is without prejudice to Sections 74.1 and 74.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 allowing the GPPB to amend the IRR, which shall be applied to all procurement activities, the advertisement, posting, or invitation of which were issued after the effectivity of the said amendment.

2. Sectional Completion of Works

If sectional completion is specified in the **Special Conditions of Contract (SCC)**, references in the Conditions of Contract to the Works, the Completion Date, and the Intended Completion Date shall apply to any Section of the Works (other than references to the Completion Date and Intended Completion Date for the whole of the Works).

3. Possession of Site

- 4.1. The Procuring Entity shall give possession of all or parts of the Site to the Contractor based on the schedule of delivery indicated in the SCC, which corresponds to the execution of the Works. If the Contractor suffers delay or incurs cost from failure on the part of the Procuring Entity to give possession in accordance with the terms of this clause, the Procuring Entity's Representative shall give the Contractor a Contract Time Extension and certify such sum as fair to cover the cost incurred, which sum shall be paid by Procuring Entity.
- 4.2. If possession of a portion is not given by the above date, the Procuring Entity will be deemed to have delayed the start of the relevant activities. The resulting adjustments in contract time to address such delay may be addressed through contract extension provided under Annex "E" of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

4. The Contractor's Obligations

The Contractor shall employ the key personnel named in the Schedule of Key Personnel indicating their designation, in accordance with ITB Clause 10.3 and specified in the BDS, to carry out the supervision of the Works.

The Procuring Entity will approve any proposed replacement of key personnel only if their relevant qualifications and abilities are equal to or better than those of the personnel listed in the Schedule.

5. Performance Security

- 5.1. Within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award from the Procuring Entity but in no case later than the signing of the contract by both parties, the successful Bidder shall furnish the performance security in any of the forms prescribed in Section 39 of the 2016 revised IRR.
- 5.2. The Contractor, by entering into the Contract with the Procuring Entity, acknowledges the right of the Procuring Entity to institute action pursuant to RA No. 3688 against any subcontractor be they an individual, firm, partnership, corporation, or association supplying the Contractor with labor, materials and/or equipment for the performance of this Contract.

6. Site Investigation Reports

The Contractor, in preparing the Bid, shall rely on any Site Investigation Reports referred to in the SCC supplemented by any information obtained by the Contractor.

7. Warranty

- 7.1. In case the Contractor fails to undertake the repair works under Section 62.2.2 of the 2016 revised IRR, the Procuring Entity shall forfeit its performance security, subject its property(ies) to attachment or garnishment proceedings, and perpetually disqualify it from participating in any public bidding. All payables of the GOP in his favor shall be offset to recover the costs.
- 7.2. The warranty against Structural Defects/Failures, except that occasioned-on force majeure, shall cover the period from the date of issuance of the Certificate of Final Acceptance by the Procuring Entity. Specific duration of the warranty is found in the SCC.

8. Liability of the Contractor

Subject to additional provisions, if any, set forth in the SCC, the Contractor's liability under this Contract shall be as provided by the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

If the Contractor is a joint venture, all partners to the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable to the Procuring Entity.

9. Termination for Other Causes

Contract termination shall be initiated in case it is determined *prima facie* by the Procuring Entity that the Contractor has engaged, before, or during the implementation of the contract, in unlawful deeds and behaviors relative to contract acquisition and implementation, such as, but not limited to corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, and obstructive practices as stated in ITB Clause 4.

10. Dayworks

Subject to the guidelines on Variation Order in Annex "E" of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, and if applicable as indicated in the SCC, the Dayworks rates in the Contractor's Bid shall be used for small additional amounts of work only when the Procuring Entity's Representative has given written instructions in advance for additional work to be paid for in that way.

11. Program of Work

- 11.1. The Contractor shall submit to the Procuring Entity's Representative for approval the said Program of Work showing the general methods, arrangements, order, and timing for all the activities in the Works. The submissions of the Program of Work are indicated in the SCC.
- 11.2. The Contractor shall submit to the Procuring Entity's Representative for approval an updated Program of Work at intervals no longer than the period stated in the SCC. If the Contractor does not submit an updated Program of Work within this period, the Procuring Entity's Representative may withhold the amount stated in the SCC from the next payment certificate and continue to withhold this amount until the next payment after the date on which the overdue Program of Work has been submitted.

12. Instructions, Inspections and Audits

The Contractor shall permit the GOP or the Procuring Entity to inspect the Contractor's accounts and records relating to the performance of the Contractor and to have them audited by auditors of the GOP or the Procuring Entity, as may be required.

13. Advance Payment

The Procuring Entity shall, upon a written request of the Contractor which shall be submitted as a Contract document, make an advance payment to the Contractor in an amount not exceeding fifteen percent (15%) of the total contract price, to be made in lump sum, or at the most two installments according to a schedule specified in the

SCC, subject to the requirements in Annex "E" of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

14. Progress Payments

The Contractor may submit a request for payment for Work accomplished. Such requests for payment shall be verified and certified by the Procuring Entity's Representative/Project Engineer. Except as otherwise stipulated in the SCC, materials and equipment delivered on the site but not completely put in place shall not be included for payment.

15. Operating and Maintenance Manuals

- 15.1. If required, the Contractor will provide "as built" Drawings and/or operating and maintenance manuals as specified in the SCC.
- 15.2. If the Contractor does not provide the Drawings and/or manuals by the dates stated above, or they do not receive the Procuring Entity's Representative's approval, the Procuring Entity's Representative may withhold the amount stated in the SCC from payments due to the Contractor.

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PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

PH-1.0 GENERAL

The purpose of this project is to prevent the erosion, settlement of the embankment dam and the fence is for the safety of the NPC Personnel in monitoring the structure in the area as well as prevention of access by unauthorized person.

PH-2.0 LOCATION

The project is located at Agus 2 HEP, Saguiaran, Lanao del Sur.

PH-3.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The major activities shall include but not limited to the following.

- a) Mobilization
- b) Clearing/Prunning
- c) Grouting of loose Riprap/lean concreting of slope riprap
- d) Fabrication, painting and installation of fence
- e) Demobilization

PH-4.0 CONTRACT PERIOD

The work duration of the entire project is **Forty Two (42) Calendar Days** reckoned from receipt of the Notice to Proceed.

The total contract period is inclusive of five (5) rainy/unworkable days considered unfavorable for the execution of works at site. The contract period shall be reckoned from the date of contract effectively as specified in the Notice to Proceed.

PH-5.0 CONTRACTOR'S CLASSIFICATION

The contractor must have a valid Philippine Contractor's Accreditation Board (PCAB) license of at least **Category C or D – General Engineering with inter-agency registration of at least Small B GE-3 (Dam, Reservoir or Tunneling)**.

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TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

TS-01 GENERAL SCOPE

The work to be done under this specification shall include the furnishing of all labor, materials, tools and other incidentals required for all the works specified herein and shown on the accompanying drawings or otherwise directed by NPC is intended to cover all materials, labor equipment necessary to complete the project as shown on the plans and as specified herein.

MATERIALS

- a) All materials to be used shall be of approved commercial quality and shall be subject for inspection and approval by NPC inspector before use.
- b) All materials to be used shall conform to applicable standard. If upon visual inspection the materials appear to be of poor quality or fail to meet the standard, the NPC inspector has the authority to reject the same outrightly.

WORKMANSHIP

The Contractor shall perform all activities necessary for the completion of the project satisfactory to NPC and in accordance with the approved plans and these specifications.

TS-02 MOBILIZATION

The Contractor shall secure clearance from the Security office to start of work and for the issuance of worker's Identification Card (I.D.). Upon approval, the Contractor shall bring to the site all necessary tools, equipment and other incidentals necessary for the proper execution of all the activities. The Contractor shall construct bunkhouse for the workmen and for the storage of all the construction materials on designated approved location.

The Contractor shall bring to the site all his necessary construction equipment and plant and install all stationary construction equipment and plant at location and in the manner approved by NPC. The Contractor shall submit sufficient detailed plans showing the proposed location of such stationary equipment and plant and other pertinent data.

The Contractor shall provide and grade his camp site, construct his camp, employee housing, warehouse and provide such related facilities and sanitary conveniences that the Contractor deems necessary for maintaining health, peace and order in the camp and work areas. The

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areas that may be used by the Contractor within the construction site shall be designated by NPC.

TS-03 CLEARING/PRUNING

a) SCOPE

This item shall consist of clearing, grubbing, removing and disposing all vegetation and debris as designated in the Contract, except those objects that are designated to remain in place or are to be removed in consonance with other provisions of this Specification. The work shall also include the preservation from injury or defacement of all objects designated to remain.

b) WORKMANSHIP

The Contractor shall perform clearing and grubbing on the project site. The site shall be cleared and grubbed of all trees and brush except particular trees, which may be retained by the NPC for preservation. Particular trees to be left in place shall be protected from scarring and/or other injuries during clearing and grubbing work and other construction operations.

All stumps, roots and brush shall be removed to a depth of Thirty (30) cm below original ground surface and disposed of in a place designated by the NPC. Downed timber, which may be ordered saved by the NPC for future use, shall be cut into logs as directed and neatly piled in a place designated by the NPC, otherwise they shall be disposed of same as above.

All surface objects and all trees, stumps, roots and other protruding obstructions, not designated to remain, shall be cleared and/or grubbed, including mowing as required, except as provided below:

- a. Removal of undisturbed stumps and roots and nonperishable solid objects with a minimum depth of one (1) meter below subgrade or slope of embankment will not be required.
- b. In areas outside of the grading limits of cut and embankment areas, stumps and nonperishable solid objects shall be cut off not more than 150 mm (6 inches) above the ground line or low water level.
- c. In areas to be rounded at the top of cut slopes, stumps shall be cut off flush with or below the surface of the final slope line.
- d. Grubbing of pits, channel changes and ditches will be required only to the depth necessitated by the proposed excavation within such areas.
- e. In areas covered by cogon/talahib, wild grass and other vegetations, top soil shall be cut to a maximum depth of 150 mm below the original ground surface or as designated by the Engineer, and disposed outside the clearing and grubbing limits as indicated in the typical roadway section.

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Except in areas to be excavated, stump holes and other holes from which obstructions are removed shall be backfilled with suitable material and compacted to the required density.

Low hanging branches and unsound or unsightly branches on trees or shrubs designated to remain shall be trimmed as directed. Branches of trees extending over the roadbed shall be trimmed to give a clear height of 6 m (20 feet) above the roadbed surface. All trimming shall be done by skilled workmen and in accordance with good tree surgery practices.

Where shown on the drawings or if not shown but directed by the NPC, the Contractor shall perform miscellaneous work like demolition, removal, chipping, replacement or transfer of existing structures and other miscellaneous work. All demolished structures shall be disposed of as directed by NPC.

c) MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Unit of measure shall be in square meter.

The accepted quantities shall be paid for at the contract unit price included in the Bill of Quantities which price and payment shall be full compensation for the removal and disposal of excavated materials including all labor, equipment, tools, and incidentals necessary to complete the work prescribed in this Item.

TS-04 GROUTING OF LOOSE RIPRAP/LEAN CONCRETE OF SLOPE RIPRAP

a) SCOPE

This Item shall consist of the furnishing and placing of loose riprap and lean concrete with or without grout as the case may be, with or without filter backing, furnished and constructed in accordance with this Specification and to the lines and grades and dimensions shown on the Plans.

b) WORKMANSHIP

Material Requirements

Stones for riprap shall consist of rock as nearly as rectangular in section as is practical, except that riprap of Class A may consist of round natural stones. The stones shall be sound, tough, durable, dense, resistant to the action of air and water, and suitable in all respects for the purpose intended.

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Stones for riprap shall be one of the following classes as shown on the Plans or determined by the Engineer

- Class A - Stones ranging from a minimum of 15kg to a maximum of 25kg with at least 50 percent of the stones weighing more than 20kg
- Class B - Stones ranging from minimum of 30kg to a maximum of 70kg with at least 50 percent of the stones weighing more than 50kg
- Class C - Stones ranging from minimum of 60kg to a maximum of 100kg with at least 50 percent of the stones weighing more than 80kg
- Class D - Stones ranging from minimum of 100kg to a maximum of 200kg with at least 50 percent of the stones weighing more than 150kg

Sound pieces of broken concrete obtained from the removal of bridges, culverts and other structures may be substituted for stone with the approval of the Engineer.

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Filter Materials

When required, the riprap shall be placed on a filter layer to prevent fine embankment materials to be washed out through the voids of the face stones. The grading of the filter material shall be as specified on the Plans, or in the Special Provisions. If not so specified, it will be required that D15 of the filter is at least 4 times the size D85 for the embankment material, where D15 percent and 85 percent, respectively, passing (by mass) in a grain size analysis. Fine aggregate passing grading requirements for Item 405, Structural Concrete, will satisfy foregoing requirements.

Mortar for grouted riprap shall consist of sand, cement and water conforming to the requirements given under Item 405, Structural Concrete, mixed in the proportion of one part cement to three parts sand by volume, and sufficient water to obtain the required consistency.

The horizontal and vertical contact surface between stones shall be embedded by cement mortar having a minimum thickness of 20 mm. Sufficient mortar shall be used to completely fill all voids leaving the face of the stones exposed.

Construction Requirements**Excavation**

The bed for riprap shall be excavated to the required depths and properly compacted, trimmed and shaped.

The riprap shall be founded in a toe trench dug below the depth of scour as shown on the Plans or as ordered by the Engineer. The toe trench shall be filled with stone of the same class as that specified for the riprap, unless otherwise specified.

Placing

Stones placed below the water line shall be distributed so that the minimum thickness of the riprap is not less than that specified.

Stones above the water line shall be placed by hand or individually by machines. They shall be laid with close, broken joints and shall be firmly bedded into the slope and against the adjoining stones. Each stone shall be laid with its longest axis perpendicular to the slope in close contact with each adjacent stone. The riprap shall be thoroughly rammed into place as construction progresses and the finished surface shall present an even, tight surface. Interstices between stones shall be filled with small broken fragments firmly rammed into place.

Unless otherwise provided, riprap shall have the following minimum thickness, measured perpendicular to the slope:

Class A – 300 mm



Class B – 500 mm

Class C – 600 mm

Class D – 800 mm

The surface of riprap shall not vary from the theoretical surface by more than 100 mm at any point.

Grouting

When grouted riprap is specified, concrete grout shall be placed by hand, or individually by pumpcrete machine as specified for loose riprap placed above the water line. The spaces between the stones riprap shall then be filled with cement mortar throughout the thickness of the riprap as specified in Subsection 504.2.3, mortar. Sufficient mortar shall be used to completely fill all voids, except that the face surface of the stones shall be left exposed.

Grout cement shall be placed from bottom to top of the surface slope riprap. After grouting is completed, the surface shall be cured as specified in Item 405, Structural Concrete for a period of at least three days.

The stones riprap shall also be laid in a manner that the vertical and horizontal alignments of the exposed face shall, as possible be maintained in a straight line.

Weepholes

All walls and abutments shall be provided with weepholes. Unless otherwise shown on the Plans or directed by the Engineer, the weepholes shall be placed horizontally at the lowest points where free outlets for water can be obtained and shall be spaced at not more than 2 m center to center in a staggered manner. The length of the weepholes shall not be less than the thickness of the walls of the abutment and shall be at least 50 mm diameter PVC or other pipe materials accepted by the Engineer. Weepholes must be provided with filter bags as specified in special provision or as directed by the Engineer, and shall be incidental to Pay Item 505.

Lean Concrete

Main function of the lean concrete is to provide the uniform surface to the foundation concrete and to prevent the direct contact of foundation concrete from the soil.

Lean concrete is a mix where the amount of cement is lower than the amount of liquid present in the strata with a mix ratio is 1:4:8 (1 Cement, 4 Sand and 8 Aggregate) 7.5 mpa.

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Placing

Lean concrete placed above the water line of the slope shall be distributed so that the minimum thickness of the lean concreting of the riprap is not less than 3 inches specified. Lean concrete is given that the uniform slope surface to the embankment riprap and to prevent the riprap and soil.

c) MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

The quantities to be measured for payment shall be the number of cubic meters of grouted riprap and lean concrete.

The accepted quantities shall be paid for at the contract unit price included in the Bill of Quantities which price and payment shall be full compensation for the grouting of riprap and lean concrete including all labor, equipment, tools, and incidentals necessary to complete the work prescribed in this Item.

TS-05 FABRICATION, PAINTING AND INSTALLATION OF FENCE**a) SCOPE**

This item shall consist of furnishing and constructing posts and guardrails of the types called for in the contract and in accordance with this Specification, at the locations, and in conformity with the lines and grades shown on the Plans, or as required by the Engineer.

This Item shall consist of furnishing and constructing posts, installation of fences AND painting in accordance with the details, and at the locations, shown on the Plans, or as required by the Engineer.

b) WORKMANSHIP

Item shall govern for the construction/Fabrication of steel railing a combination of these materials on spillway walls as shown on the plans.

In general, steel railing shall include that portion of the structure erected on or along the edges of walk of spillway wall and shall include any tie-in anchorage to approach the existing steel railing or guard fence. Steel railing, including the necessary anchorage, shall be in accordance with these specifications and the details shown on the plans.

Welding Works

Welding in shop and field shall be done by operators having been previously qualified by test prescribed in the American Welding society "Standard Qualification Procedure" to perform the type of work required. Equipment shall be



of the type, which produce proper current so that operator may produce satisfactory welds. The welding machine shall be of 200 - 400 amperes, 200 -240 volts capacity.

Unless otherwise shown on the Plans, the following low hydrogen electrodes shall be used and shall be suitable for positions and other conditions of intended use in accordance with the instruction with each container.

- a. The technique of welding employed, the appearance and quality of welds made, and the methods of correcting defective work shall conform to the American Welding society code for arc Welding in Building Construction,
- b. Surfaces to be welded shall be free from loose scale, rust, grease, paint and other foreign material except that mill scale, which withstands vigorous wire brushing, may remain.
- c. Finish members shall be true to line and free from twists, bends and open joints.

Steel Railing

Fabrication and erection of steel railing shall conform to the pertinent provisions of the Item "Steel Structures" and to the requirements of these specifications. Splicing of members will be permitted only as provided by the plans. All splice locations and details shall be shown on the shop or erection drawings. For steel railing, shop or erection drawings shall be prepared and forwarded for approval in accordance with the requirements of the Item "Steel Structures". Field welding shall be in accordance with the Item "Steel Structures". Pipe rail and posts, shall fabricated in the field and shall be welded/mounted in a steel base plate and accurately spaced with respect to each other and while assembled shall be completely welded and bolted in the installed expansion bolt. All surfaces to be welded shall be free from loose scale, rust, grease, paint and other foreign material except that mill scale, which withstands vigorous wire brushing, may remain clean. Finish members shall be true to line and free from twists and bends as required by the plans, as each steel rail section is completely assembled and connection, the adjacent section shall be set in its proper relative position with the ends engaged and remain in this position until completely connected. Each pair of sections shall be match marked so they may be erected in the same order in which they were fabricated. The fabricated elements for steel railing shall conform to the dimensions and cross section shown on the plans. The steel rail shall be straight and free from warp. The maximum deviation for straightness of either edge of a full length section shall be one-half of

an inch. Steel Rail elements shall be jointed and connected to the rail posts as shown on the plans.

Concrete pedestal of the Railing

The concrete pedestal of railing shall be made of Class A Concrete, and to the requirements of this specification. Provisions shall be made in constructing forms to provide for checking and correction of railing lines and the 2" inches (G.I) pipe shall be embedded grades of the concrete has been placed, but before initial set. The finish floating of the steel railing tops shall not disturb the form alignment after the final check. Particular care shall be exercised in other construction operations to avoid disturbing or vibrating the span with the newly placed steel railing. Reinforcing steel for concrete railing shall conform to the design plans and per approval of NPC personnel (DRWMD) to secure the alignment and the grade line.

Painting

All metal surfaces shall be washed with minerals spirits to remove any dirt grease before applying coats. Where rust or scale is present, it shall be wired brushed or sand papered clean before painting. Shop coats of paint that becomes marred shall be cleaned and touched up or finished before the finished coats are applied.

All metal surfaces shall be properly prepared, cleaned, or chemically treated before applying the first coat of paint in one of the following ways:

All exposed surface shall be cleaned with diluted acetic acid to remove grease or oil and slight indications of oxidation and rust over the surface, then rinsed with clean water. The surface must be thoroughly dry before the paint is applied or shall be thoroughly cleaned with gasoline and coated with solution consisting of 4 ounces of copper sulphate in one gallon of water. This coating shall remain on surfaces not less than 12 hours and then duster off with stiff fiber bristle brush. Paint shall be thoroughly and uniformly brushed on, so as to form a film of even thickness. Paint shall be thoroughly stirred so as to keep the pigment evenly in suspension while paint is applied. Each part of paint shall be allowed to dry thoroughly and inspected for approval before the succeeding coat is applied. No oil paint shall be done in damp weather. All surface shall be thoroughly clean and dry before any paints is applied. Except where otherwise indicated, all paints shall be applied in three (3) coats (priming, body and finish). The painter's brush (nylon brush) shall be used.

Priming coat, first quality Red Oxide Paint shall be applied before the installing and securely fitting in place all metal works. After they are fitted in place, the priming coat shall first be touched up or refinished, then allowed to dry thoroughly, and finally finished with two (2) coats of first quality metallic paint of the color approved in the scheme. All exposed steel shall be painted with steel primer and finished with two coats of reflector traffic paint black paint and reflector traffic paint yellow. Concrete pedestal shall be painted in 3 coats.




Upon completion of work, remove all paint spots splattered on concrete surface. Remove from the premises all surplus materials, scaffolds, rubbish and accumulated materials of whatever nature and leave the work area in clean, orderly and acceptable condition.

Finished surfaces shall be solid, of even color and finished texture, free from drops, runs, lumps, brush marks, discoloration or other defects. Before final inspection, any work which has become damaged or discolored shall be touched up or refinished in satisfactory manner.

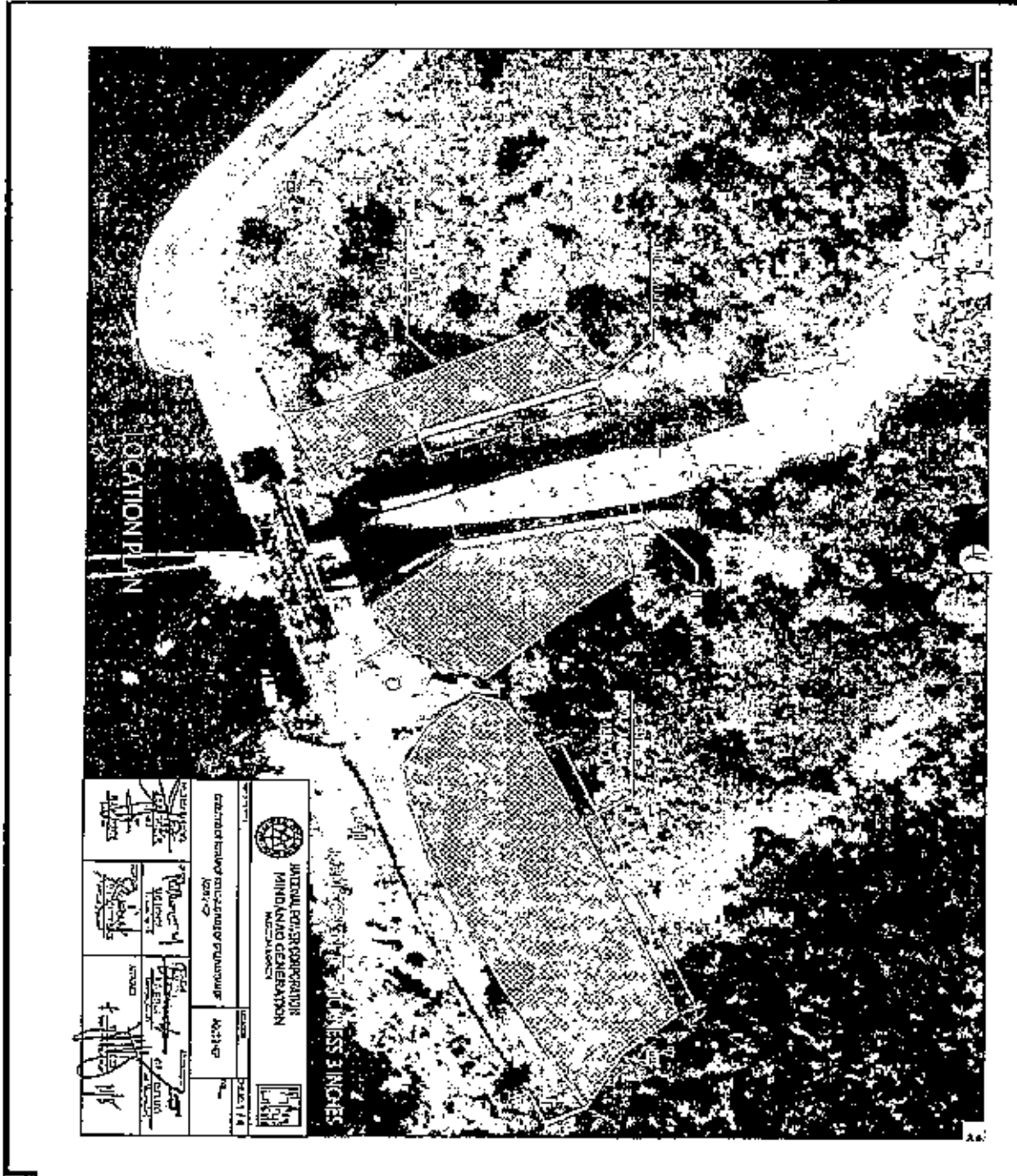

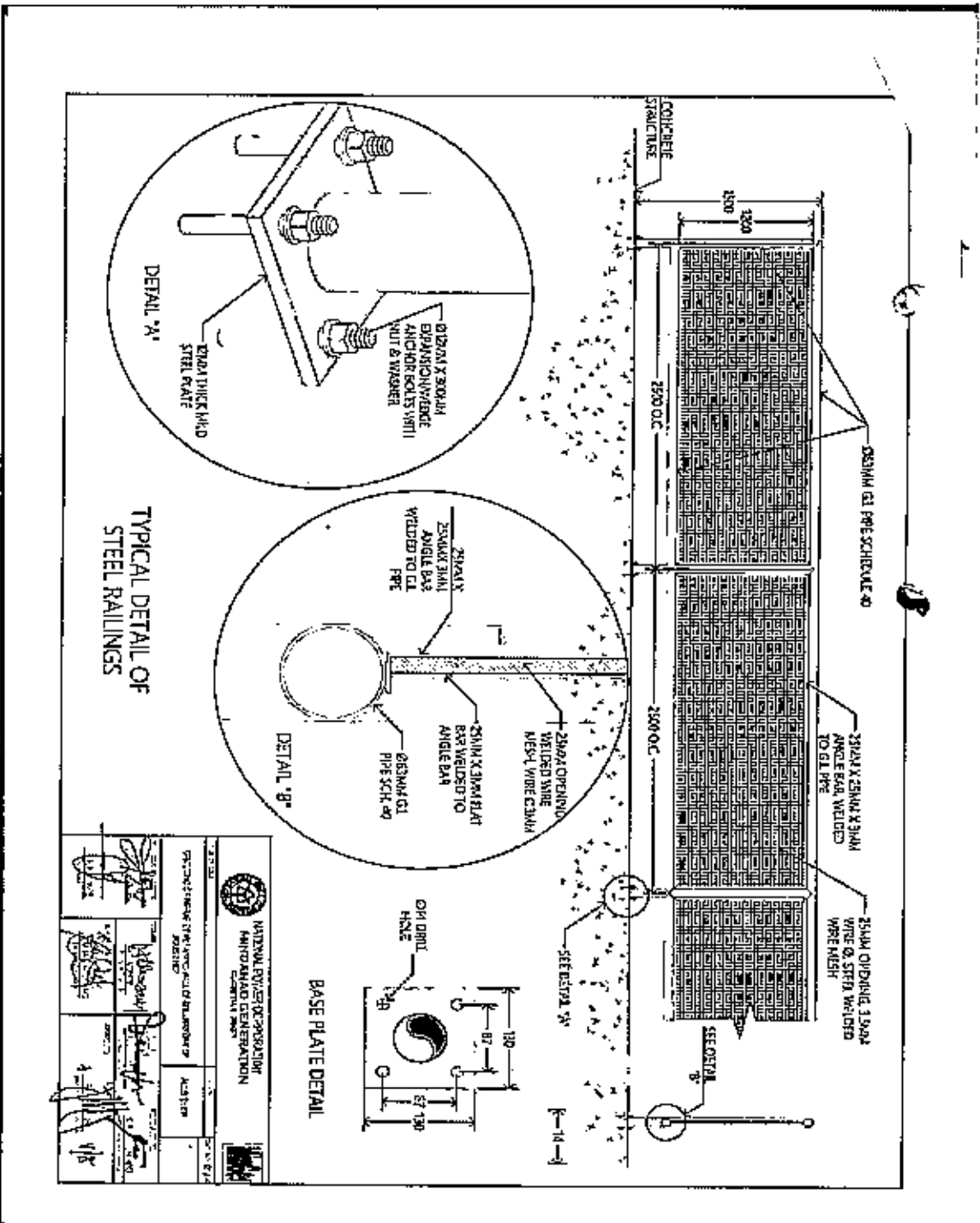

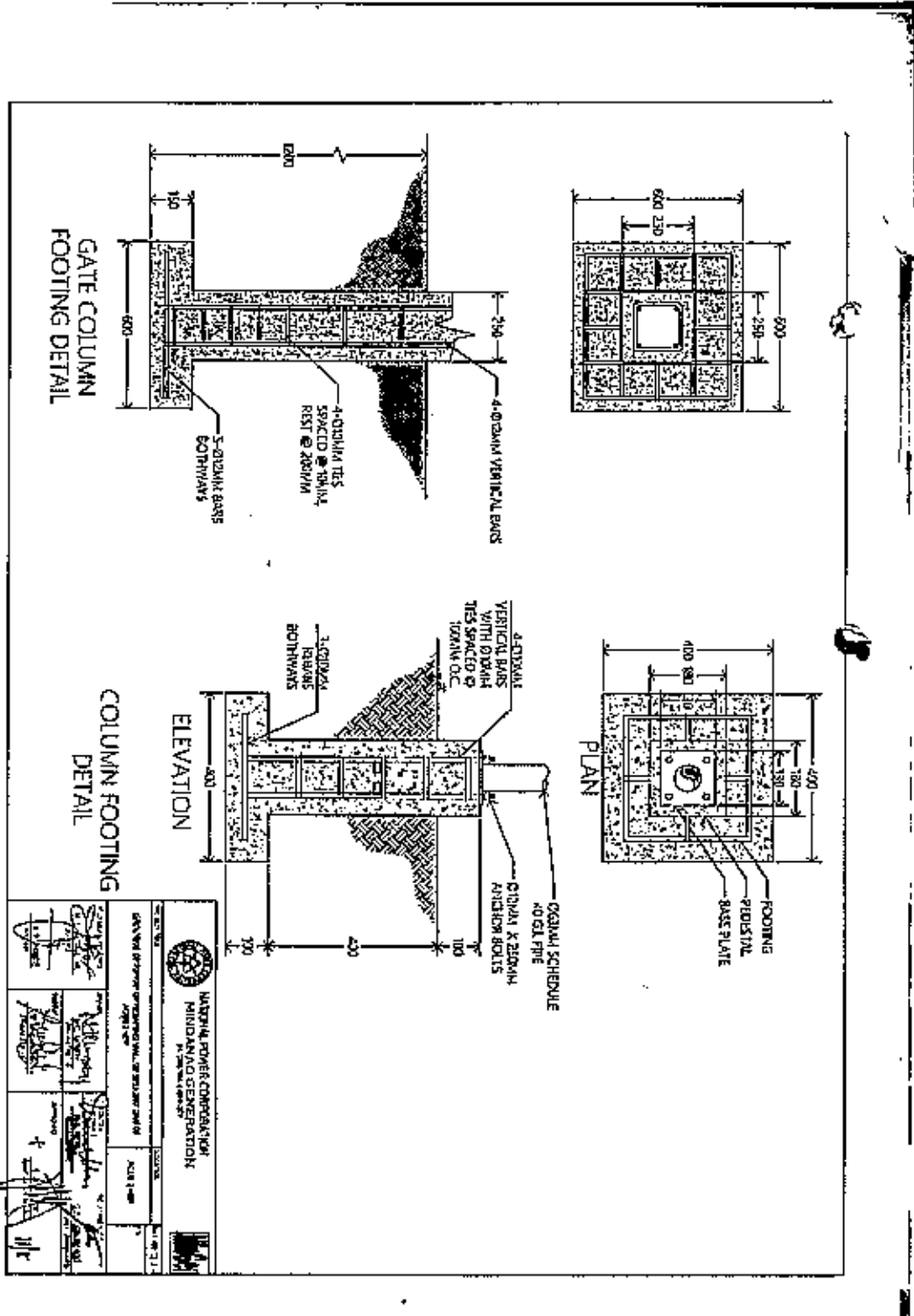
Sheet No. 1/4-	Site Location Plan

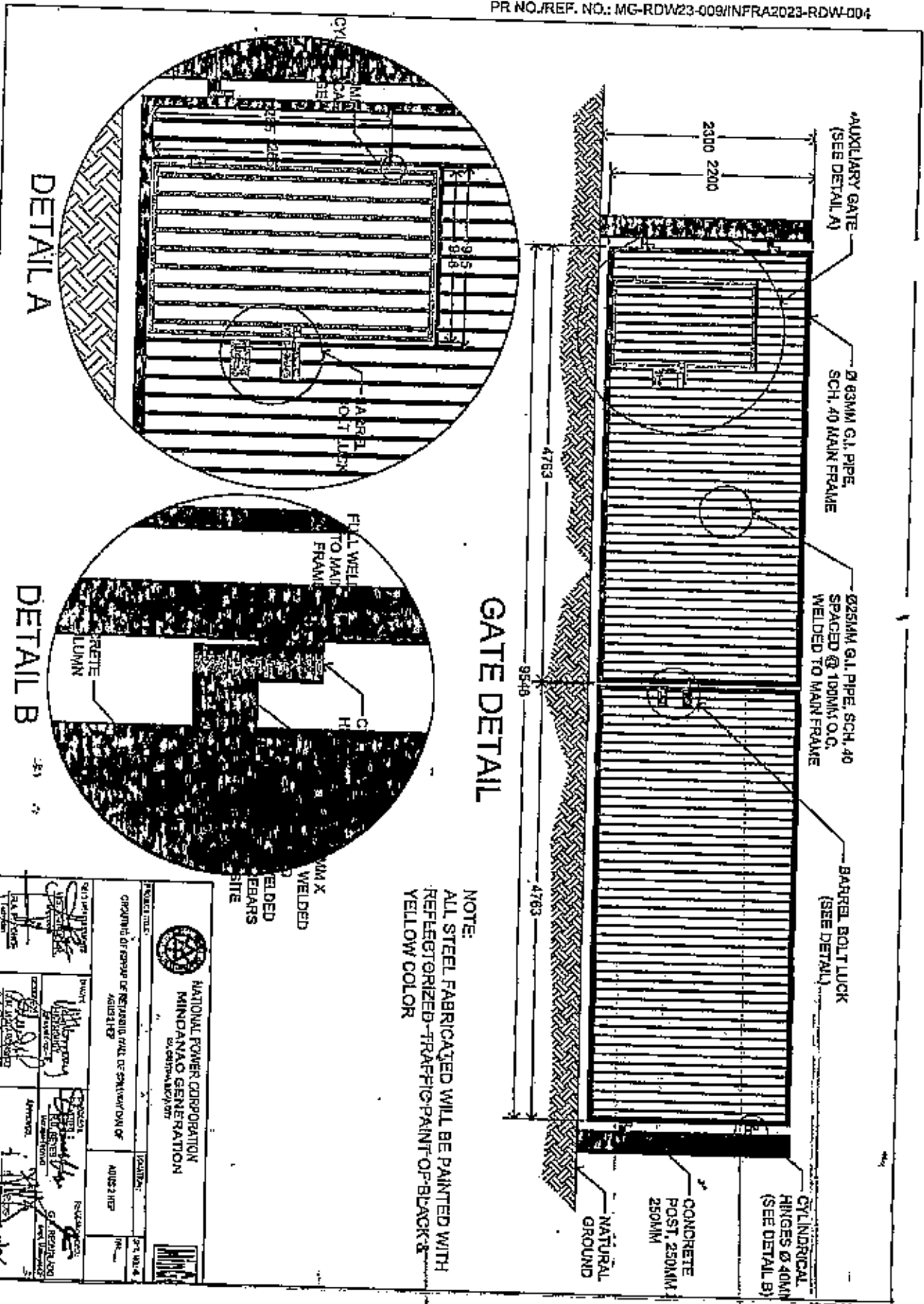
