#### 2. Delivery Period

Delivery Period shall not be later than **Sixty (60) calendar days** upon receipt of the Purchase Order / Notice to Proceed.

#### 3. Delivery Point

Items shall be delivered at NPC-Head Office, Diliman, Quezon City.

#### 4. Bid Submission

The Bidder shall submit their bids through their authorized representative or in the manner of submission as prescribed in the RFQ.

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#### 5. Late Bids

Any Bid submitted after the deadline for submission and receipt of Bids shall not be accepted by NPC.

#### 6. Bid Prices

The bid price as indicated in the Quotation Form shall be fixed during the Bidder's performance of the Contract and not subject to variation or price escalation on any account. A Bid submitted with an adjustable price quotation shall be treated as non-responsive.

#### 7. Bid Price Validity

Price Validity shall not be less than One Hundred Twenty (120) calendar days from date of bid submission.

#### 8. Eligibility Criteria

- Bids shall be checked using the PASS / FAIL Criteria for Legal, Technical and Financial components.
- From the bids that were rated PASSED, the same shall be ranked and corrected for computational errors to identify the Lowest Calculated Quotation (LCQ).

## 9. Detailed Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

The LCQ shall be subjected to detailed evaluation against the Technical Specifications including arithmetical computations. Documents which are deemed not to comply with the requirements of the tender shall be considered non-complying.

#### 10. Post-qualification

Submitted documents of the LCQ shall be subjected to post qualification evaluation. The bid that PASSED the Post-Qualification shall be declared as the Lowest Calculated Responsive Quotation (LCRQ).

#### 11. Total Contract Price

The Total Contract Price shall be inclusive of all taxes and other related expenses / charges.

#### 12. Notice to Supplier

- The supplier shall pick-up the Purchase Order (PO)/ Notice to Proceed (NTP) from NPC within two (2) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award.
- Failure to secure the PO/NTP by the supplier within the said period will mean cancellation of the same and imposition of penalties as prescribed by law.

#### 13. PO Effectivity

a. The PO Shall take effect immediately upon receipt of the PO / NTP by the supplier sent through fax as evidenced by the fax transmission receipt and as confirmed by the supplier's representative.



#### 14. Terms of Payment

Terms of Payment shall be thirty (30) calendar days after submission of complete supporting documents.

#### 15. Warranty

Warranty is dependent upon the nature/type of the item which is included in the offer (i.e. Manufacturer's Warranty).

### 16. Liquidated Damages

Where the supplier refuses or fails to satisfactorily complete the work within the specified contract time, plus any time of extension duly granted and is hereby in default under the contract, the supplier shall pay NPC for liquidated damages, and not by way of penalty, an amount equal to at least one tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the undelivered/unperformed portion of the items/works for every day of delay. Once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, the procuring entity may rescind or terminate the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it (Section 68 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184).

#### 17. Liability of the Supplier

If after receipt of the Purchase Order, the supplier fails to deliver the goods, appropriate sanctions will be imposed as prescribed under Republic Act (RA) 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).

#### 18. Disclosure of Relations



#### TS-1.0 GENERAL

This specification covers the technical requirements for the supply, delivery and testing of Brand New two (2) sets of Self-Contained Underwater Breathing Apparatus (SCUBA) Diving Gears for Environmental Management Dept. — EMAD. Other parts and accessories which are not specifically mentioned herein but are necessary for the proper assembly and operation of the equipment shall be furnished.

All materials to be used and incorporated into the equipment shall be new and unused. They shall be suitable for the intended purpose and shall comply with all applicable regulations, quality, and standards.

The Supplier shall accept full responsibility for his work including performance qualifications, specifications, documentation, reports, fabrication, assembly, corrosion protection, shop testing, preparation for shipment, field testing, warranty provisions and compliance with the applicable codes and standards and the requirements of this Specification.

#### TS-2.0 SCOPE OF WORKS

The scope of work shall cover but not limited to the supply, delivery, and testing of **two (2) sets of SCUBA Diving Gears** complete with other parts and accessories necessary for its proper assembly and operation.

## TS-3.0 DELIVERY PERIOD AND LOCATION

Delivery period shall not be later than sixty (60) calendar days upon receipt of the Purchase Order/ Notice to Proceed.

#### TS-5.0 TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Provide training for two (2) EMD Personnel on open water training course and use of SCUBA diving gears. The said training will be able to acquire open water SCUBA Certification for the trained EMD Personnel. All in cost for the open water training course and certification shall be included in the bid.

## TS-6.0 TESTING AND ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

The Supplier shall perform at his own expense all tests required to ensure adequacy of design, material, workmanship, and conformance of the supplied equipment to the requirements of the specifications and standards.

Upon arrival of the SCUBA diving gears at delivery site, NPC and the Supplier or their authorized representatives, shall jointly verify the SCUBA diving gears following the steps below:

- a. Inspection and verification of the packing list.
- b. Visual inspection of the condition of the packing and its surfaces; and
- c. Opening of the crates and plastic sheet protection of component to verify the content and its physical condition and to check pilferage or damage during shipment and storage.

A record shall be prepared carefully noting all eventual shortages, defects, or damages, signed by the Supplier and concurred by NPC. All shortages and damages noted shall be immediately replaced by the Supplier at his own cost and shall ensure the timely delivery of replacement without affecting the agreed overall contract implementation schedule.

The SCUBA diving gears shall be tested to ensure and verify that the performance and operation are in accordance with the requirements of the Specifications.

Certificate of Acceptance shall be issued only after all the required tests are satisfactorily conducted and results are within the acceptable range, and the requirements of the technical specifications and training certificates are met.
