



WHAT	Apprehension of Square Logs in Sitio Palanas, Brgy. San Antonio, Kalayaan, Laguna
WHEN	August 12, 2021
WHERE	Sitio Palanas, Brgy. San Antonio, Kalayaan, Laguna
WHY	<p>On August 12, 2021 (Thursday), Caliraya-Lumot Watershed Area Team (CLWAT) under the Watershed Management Department of the National Power Corporation (NPC) received an information on an illegal activity in So. Palanas, Brgy. San Antonio, Kalayaan, Laguna. Upon receiving the information, CLWAT and 202nd Infantry (Unifier) Brigade Philippine Army conducted a joint patrol operation in the mentioned Sitio.</p> <p>CLWAT apprehended fifty (50) pieces of assorted species of square logs with a total volume of two thousand two hundred sixty (2,260) board feet and carried necessary documentation such as issuance of Apprehension Receipt, On Site Report, On Site record of Violation, and Custody Receipt. Also, a copy of Apprehension Receipt was posted in the area where apprehension took place for the information of the public regarding the incident.</p> <p>Consequently, CLWAT field operatives collected and lugged the apprehended items to NPC-CLWAT impounding area at NPC Camarin Compound, Brgy. West Talaongan, Cavinti, Laguna for custody, safekeeping, and disposition in accordance to NPC Circular No. 2014-014.</p>

WHO	NPC-UARWAT, Lot owner, Nabalicong Communities and Youth .
WHAT	Implementation of Tree Planting activity with Information Education Communication Campaign.
WHEN/ WHERE	On June 17, 18 and 24, 2021, NPC-UARWAT has initiated a tree planting activity with IEC at Nabalicong, Buguias.
WHY	<p>In line with the National Power Corporation Watershed Protection program, the UARWAT has programmed tree planting activities that would enjoin and increase participation of line stakeholders to help rehabilitated and stabilize area from soil erosion and degradation.</p> <p>The activity was participated in by youth and communities of Nabalicong, Buguias, Lot owner and NPC-UARWAT with a total of Twenty-five (25) participants. Activities conducted includes hauling of seedlings to the planting site, strip brushing/cleaning of weeds, hole digging and planting. A total of 3, 125 mixture of coffee and alnus seedlings were planted in 5 hectares with a 4 by 4 wide spacing.</p> <p>After the planting activity, a brief IEC was conducted highlighting the importance of planting of trees especially in landslide/soil eroded prone areas in Nabalicong, Buguias. Plans and programs of NPC-UARWAT was also discussed specifically the implementation of the forestry laws and regulation thru forest patrol and detection of illegal activities within the Upper Agno River watershed jurisdiction. Seedling Dispersal program was also highlighted encouraging communities to avail the program for backyard planting of fruit trees and for barangay/community bayanihan tree planting.</p>
OTHER DETAILS	Health protocols were still observed before, during and after the conduct of the activity.

WHAT	Implementation of Tree Planting activity with Information Education Communication Campaign.
WHEN/ WHERE	On June 25, 2021, NPC-UARWAT has joined a tree planting activity with IEC at Loacan, Itogon, Benguet.
WHY	<p>As part of the protection and rehabilitation program of the Upper Agno River Watershed Area Team (UARWAT), community based actions/activities like the tree planting with Information Education Communication Campaign (IEC) was conducted in order to help rehabilitate and stabilize targeted area from soil erosion and degradation. This also aims to strengthen the partnership with stakeholders and solicit their participation in the rehabilitation, conservation and protection of the watershed.</p> <p>A joint tree planting activity with IEC was conducted on June 25, 2021 at Barangay Loacan, Itogon, Benguet which was participated by the Barangay officials and staffs, Sanguniang Kabataan/members, Barangay Tanod, Barangay Health Workers, PNP, NPC-UARWAT, and the communities. UARWAT was able to disperse 100 Benguet Pine seedlings and 300 coffee seedlings which was planted by 35 tree planters/participants while some of the planted seedlings (Benguet pine) were requested from the other agencies. A brief IEC was conducted after the activity highlighting the plans and programs of NPC-UARWAT and the importance of protecting/conserving of our watershed.</p>
