- 1. Watershed 101 and Learning Session on Energy Carbon Sequestration;
- 2. Learning Session on Geothermal Power Plant Operation;
- 3. Livelihood within Tiwi Watershed Reservation: An Experiential Session;
- 4. Observational Learning Sessions on Missionary Electrification; and
- 5. On-site learning sessions on operations and maintenance of geothermal power plants with executives and technical personnel of Aboitiz Power Renewables Inc.

The Members of the National Power Board usually visit satellite offices at least twice a year for learning sessions on diesel generating set operation, watershed management, dams administration and other resource management services, transmission and substation functions of NPC. Due to the COVID19 pandemic and inclement weather, however, the following activities were cancelled although the NP Board members are already within the vicinity:

- a. On-site learning sessions on diesel power plant operation and fuel management concerning the following:
 - i. Batan Diesel Power Plant
 - ii. Rapu-rapu Diesel Power Plant

The Office of the Corporate Secretary and the Training and Development Division (TDD) of the Human Resources Department further arrange and fund the attendance of the Appointive Member of the National Power Board to conferences, courses, trainings and seminars relevant to the power sector and to the discharge of his functions and duties as President and CEO of the Corporation.
