FINDINGS/OBSERVATIONS	ACTIONS TAKEN/ TO BE TAKEN
A. Conduct of Drill/Exercise	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> CRT members, NPC Employees and Guests evacuated quickly. Rescuers should directly go to the room and rescue the victim. The victim was not carried/transferred properly to the medical station. Fire detection and alarm system (FDAS) had an SD card and battery malfunction during the drill. The firefighting team needs more practice of their role. The evacuation team was not able to assist the visitors to their designated evacuation area. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To be maintained. Rescuers need to be alert of the situation and prioritize lives at all times. To train rescuers how to rescue by carry techniques. FDAS needs to be maintained operational at all times. Habitual practice of the firefighting team shall be maintained. CRT Members must familiarize the designated evacuation plan.

FINDINGS/OBSERVATIONS	ACTIONS TAKEN/ TO BE TAKEN
A. Conduct of Drill/Exercise	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> CRT Firefighters need improvement on how to use fire hoses. CRT Vest has no position/rank indicated Visitors should be assisted during the drill. During evacuation, evacuees must avoid bringing unnecessary items. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To practice and be familiarized on how to lay and connect fire hoses as well as other firefighting equipment. To provide/include in the next purchase of vest. Nearest CRT member to guide the visitors to Duck, Cover & Hold and lead them to the evacuation/assembly area. CRT must inform evacuees to lessen the items to be brought out during emergencies.
B. Behavioral Aspect	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All CRT, Medical and Security were well coordinated. CRT members properly guided the evacuees to the evacuation/assembly area. The evacuation time was not too fast or slow and no horseplay was accounted. The rescue operation to the victim was well executed. The communication/announcement was loud and clear. 	} To be maintained/sustained
